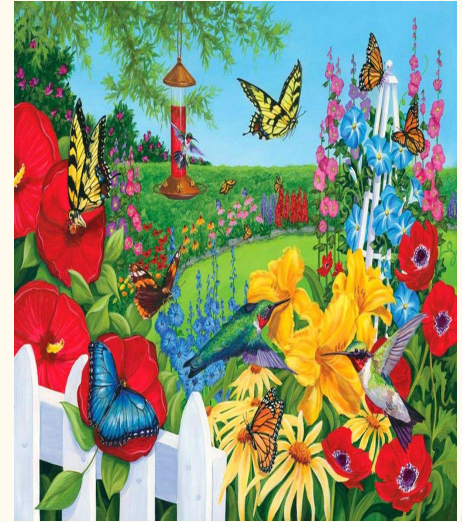
Spring Symphony

Exploring Spring with Famous Artists

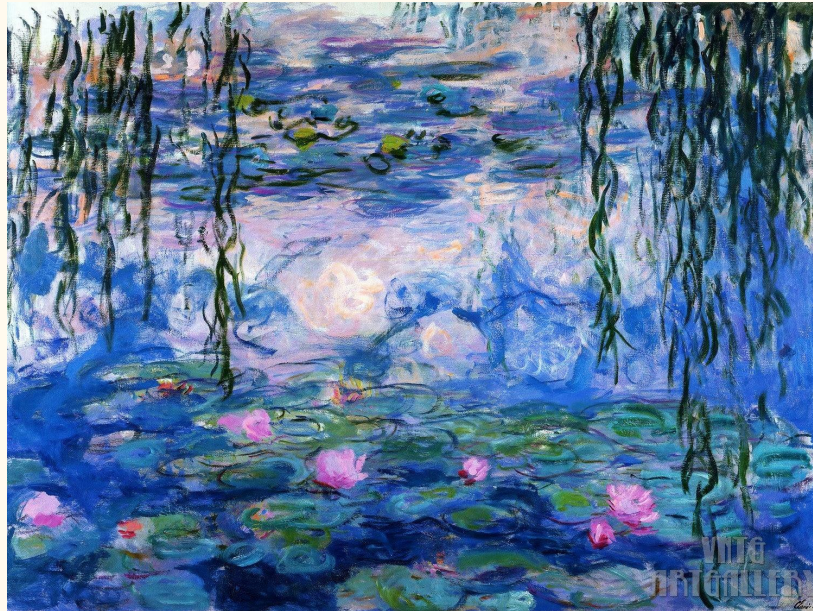
Vincent van Gogh

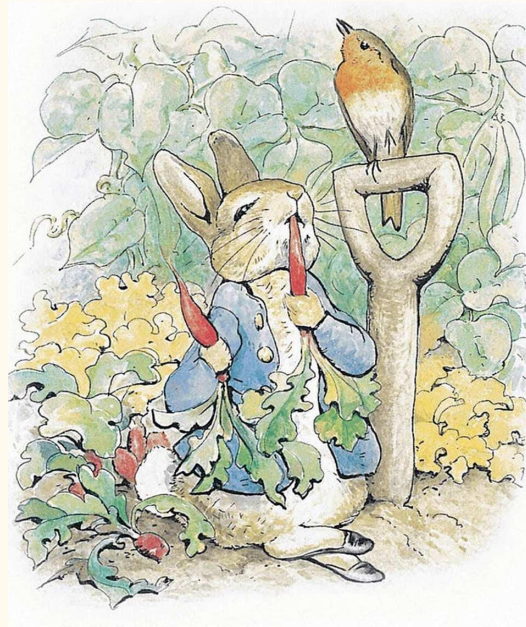
Claude Monet
